Sweet English Lavenders (hardy, reliable, very fragrant & tasty)

..... The best fragrance= the best culinary Lavender!

1. Lavandula angustifolia "Ashdowne Forest" (lovely clear English blue bloom)
2. Lavandula angustifolia delphinensis (UK "Twickle Purple")
3. Lavandula angustifolia "French Perfume" ... limited
4. Lavandula angustifolia "Happy Valley" (our seed/mixed bloom colours)
5. Lavandula angustifolia "Hidcote" (UK seed, our deepest purple bloom)
6. Lavandula angustifolia "Hidcote Giant" ... limited
7. Lavandula angustifolia "Jean Davis" (pink bloom)
8. Lavandula angustifolia "Maillette" (slender French blue)
9. Lavandula angustifolia "Mellissa" (silver leaf, pale pink bloom)
10. Lavandula angustifolia "Munstead" (UK seed, blue hedging variety)
11. Lavandula angustifolia "Provence Blue" (new one from Richter's)
12. Lavandula angustifolia "Royal Velvet" ... limited
13. Lavandula angustifolia "Seal"...limited
14. Lavandula angustifolia "UK 2007" (seed I collected from stately homes/castles)
15. Lavandula vera (dark bloom, Dutch seed)
16. Lavandula angustifolia "Seal"

Spanish Lavenders (beautiful constant blooming; half hardy)

.....Favourites for patio pots with their flamboyant topknot blooms!

1. Lavandula stoechas "Marshwood" (ruffled wings)
2. Lavandula stoechas "Otto Quast" (hardest of the lots, good bi-colour)
3. Lavandula stoechas "Snowman" (dwarf, white bloom) ... limited
4. Lavandula viridis "Goldberg" (green-gold leaf & bloom) ... limited
5. Lavandula viridis...species original "green" Lavender ... limited

Spike Lavenders (very tall, hardy, blooms later than Sweet Lavenders)

...Historical "Monks" Lavender originally from Rome, great for crafts!

1. Lavandula latifolia "Alba" or "White Spike"
2. Lavandula latifolia "Monks" (original species)
3. Lavandula latifolia "Mrs Stone's" (historic one from heritage property)

Winged Spike or "Pterostachys" Lavender (tender, continuous bloom)

.....Treat this as a fabulous no fuss annual, especially in your patio pots!

1. Lavandula multifida "Fernleaf" (amazing sapphire blue bloom) ... limited

Lavandins (very popular hybrid; very tall, hardy & abundant blue blooms!)

L. angustifolia crossed with L. latifolia= L. x intermedia

.....Larger Lavender overall with very tall slender blooms & lots of them!

1. Lavandula x intermedia "Fred Boutin" (silver foliage)
2. Lavandula x intermedia "Grosso" (largest one)
3. Lavandula x intermedia "Provence" (sweetest one)

Woolly Lavenders (hybrid; hardy, velvety silver foliage, deep purple)

L. angustifolia crossed with species L. lanata

.....*Very beautiful potted in your borders to lift & protect for winter & bees love it too.*

1. Lanata x "Ana Luisa" (bold, tallest one)
2. Lanata x "Andreas"
3. Lanata x "England" (most compact, very silver foliage)
4. Lanata x "Sawyers"

True French Lavender (bloom has praying hands petals at top)

.....*Identify this one by its notched edge on its silvery leaves: sadly one of the least hardy for Victoria when our winter turns extra soggy & cold.*

1. Lavandula dentata "Goodwin Creek" ... hummingbirds love this one!
